Mr. Long asked for any Citizen's Comments. Mrs. Julie Stover, 115 Kilgannon Road, Lancaster, PA addressed the board with her concerns about the 1:1 laptop program at the middle school. She feels that more security is needed to keep students safe while using the internet and also that parents and students need more education on internet safety.

The upcoming board opportunities were reviewed. Dr. Frerichs alerted the board to upcoming legislation that will impact schools.

Mr. Jeff Roth introduced Ms. Caroline Lovett as the new head girls' lacrosse coach. Ms. Lovett is a 2011 Penn Manor graduate and was recently hired as a 4<sup>th</sup> grade teacher in the district. Ms Lovett played lacrosse for Penn Manor and Washington College and coached a competitive club lacrosse team in Maryland.

Mrs. Rhonda Lord reviewed the Interest Rate Management Plan resolution that was placed on this evening's voting meeting agenda at the previous meeting.

Mr. Johnston reviewed the latest proposal from Columbia Water for an easement on school district property near the corner of Donnerville and Charlestown Roads for the purpose of erecting a chlorine booster station.
