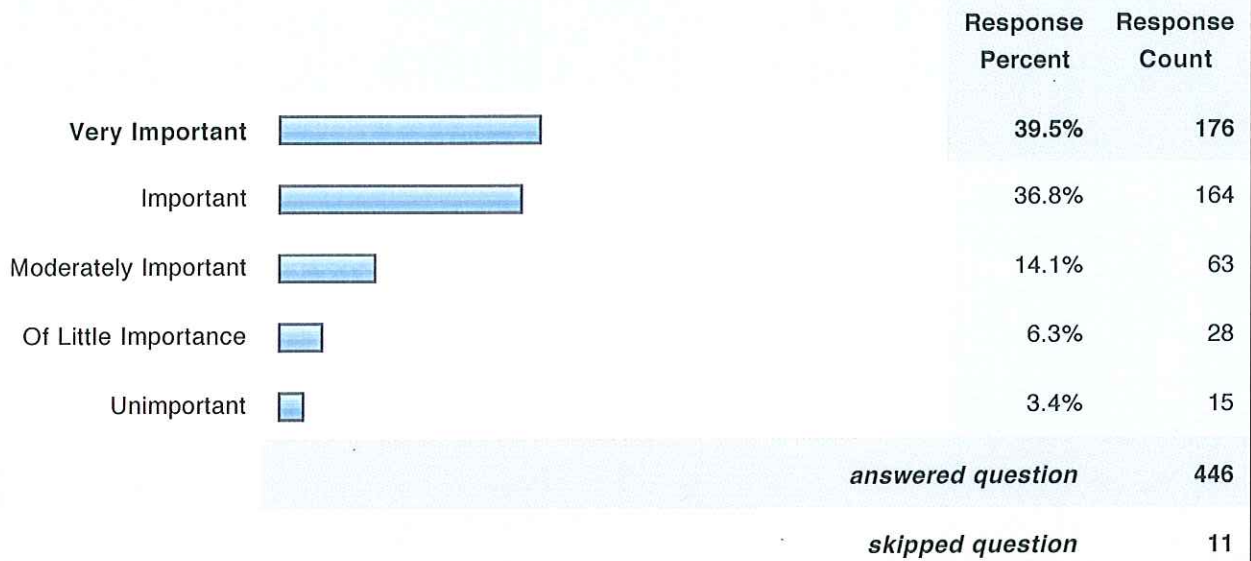
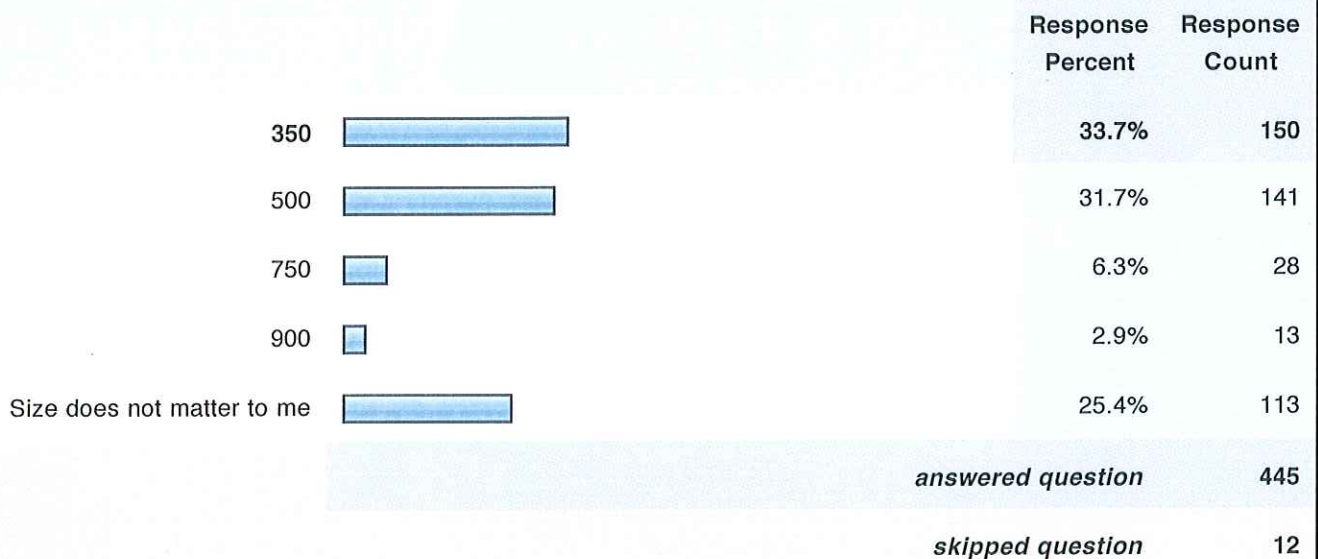

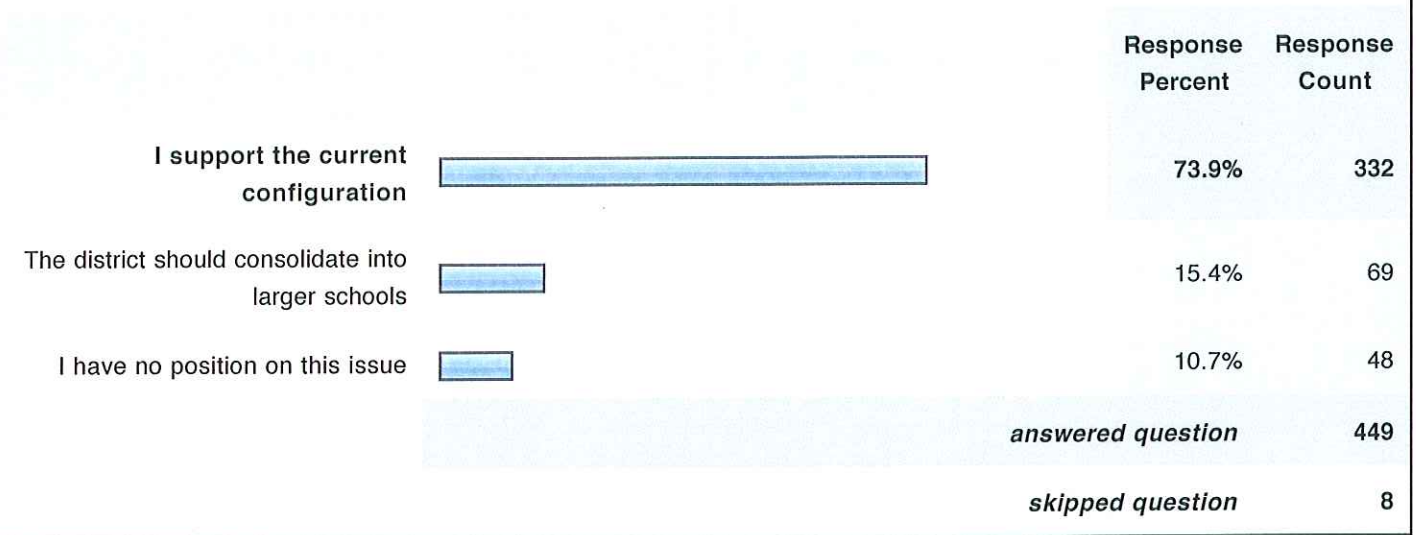
1. How important is the issue of student enrollment in a building?



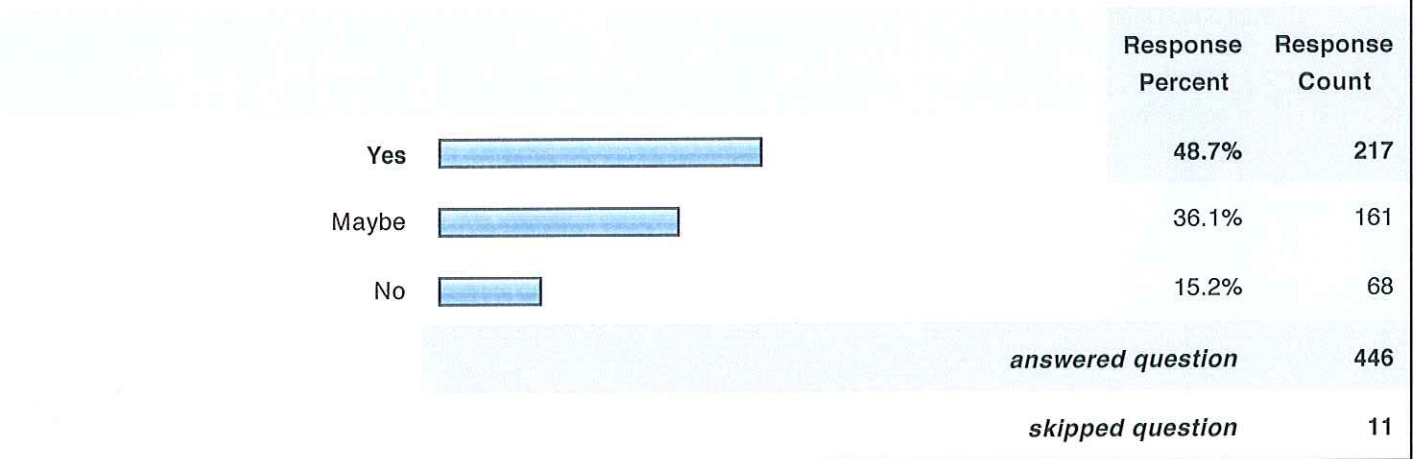

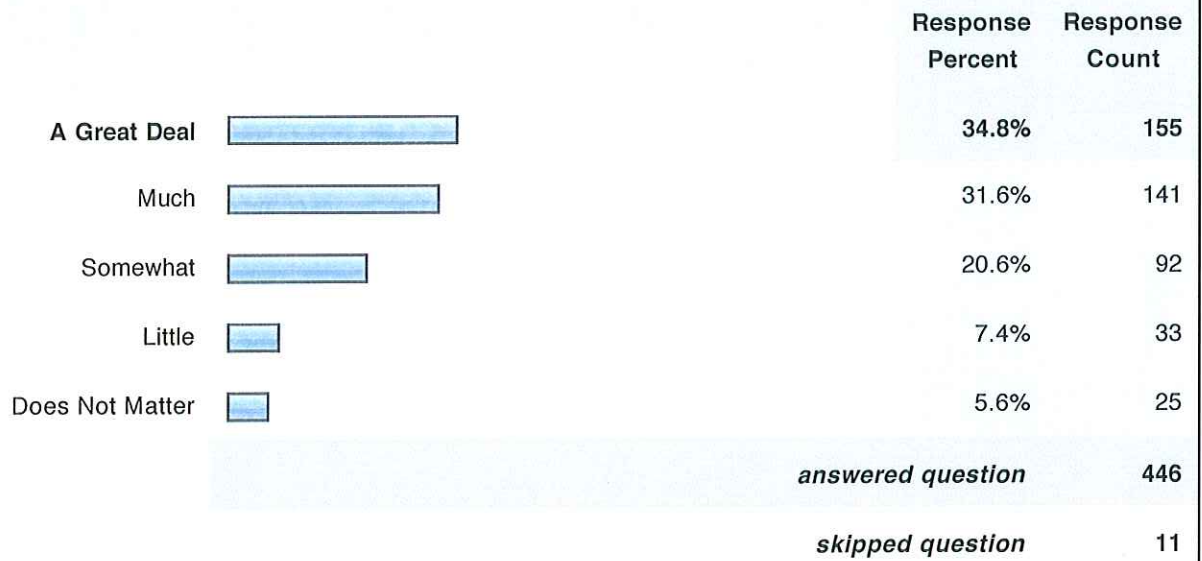
3. Do you believe that the district should continue with its philosophy of supporting seven smaller elementary schools or should buildings be consolidated into larger schools?



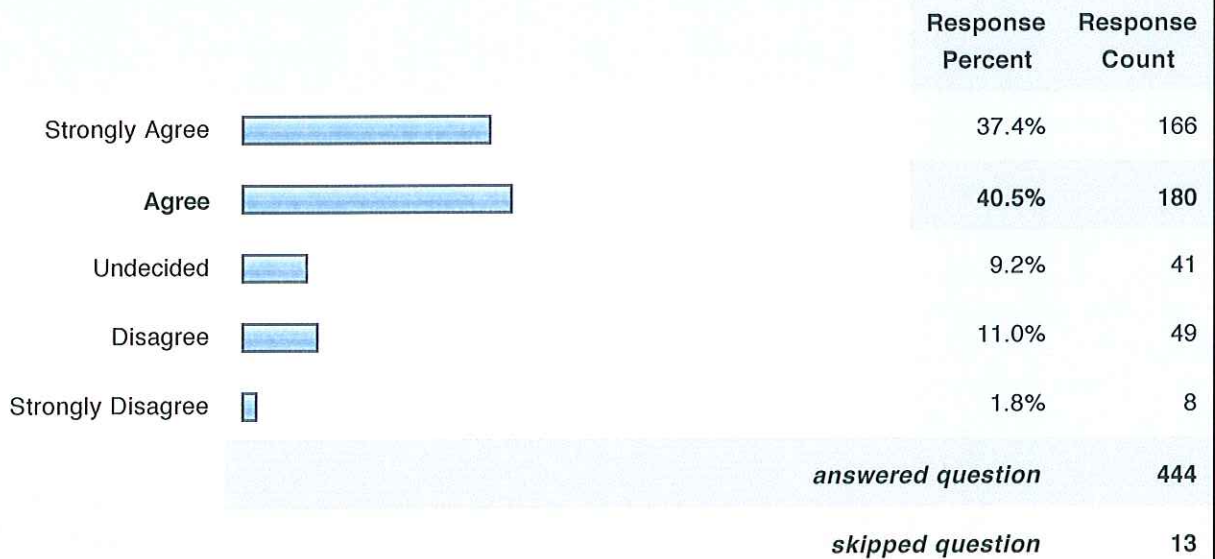
4. Should the district consider realigning attendance boundary lines to manage school size (i.e. change the school for a particular home or neighborhood)?



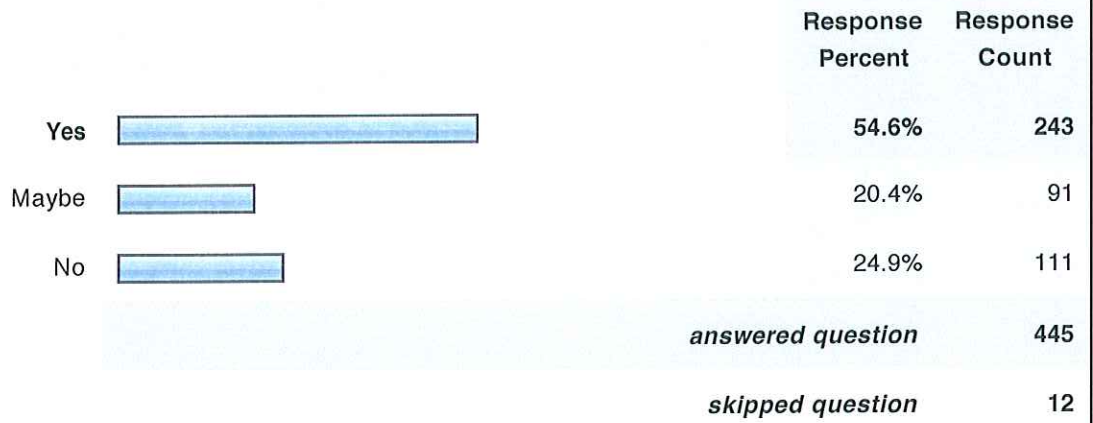
5. How much does grade configuration matter to you as an issue (i.e. buildings with grouping of students in patterns such as K-6, 7-8, 9-12)?



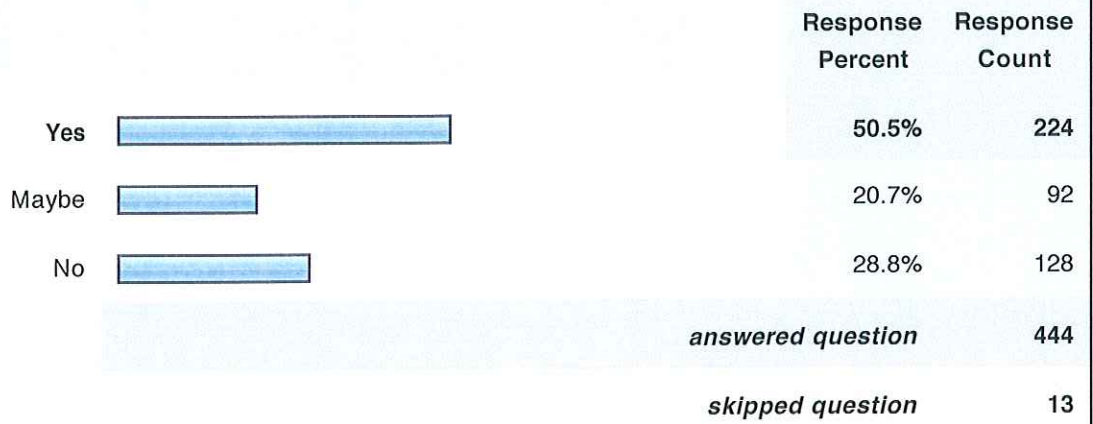
6. Do you agree that the current building configurations of K-6, 7-8, and 9-12 is an appropriate way to group students in Penn Manor?



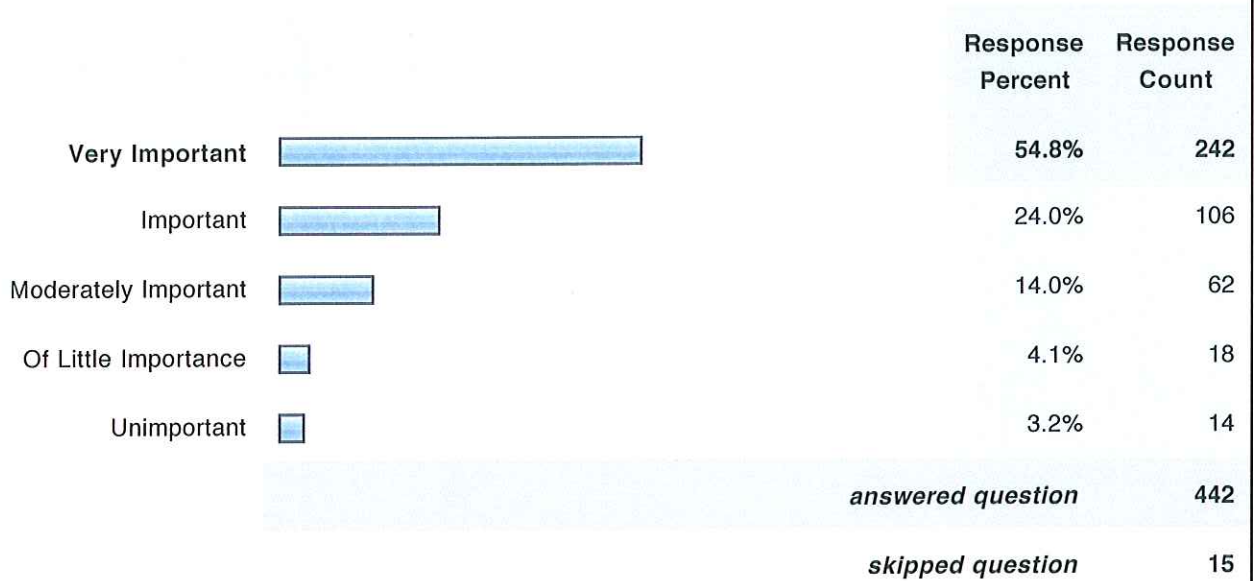
7. Do you support full-day kindergarten?



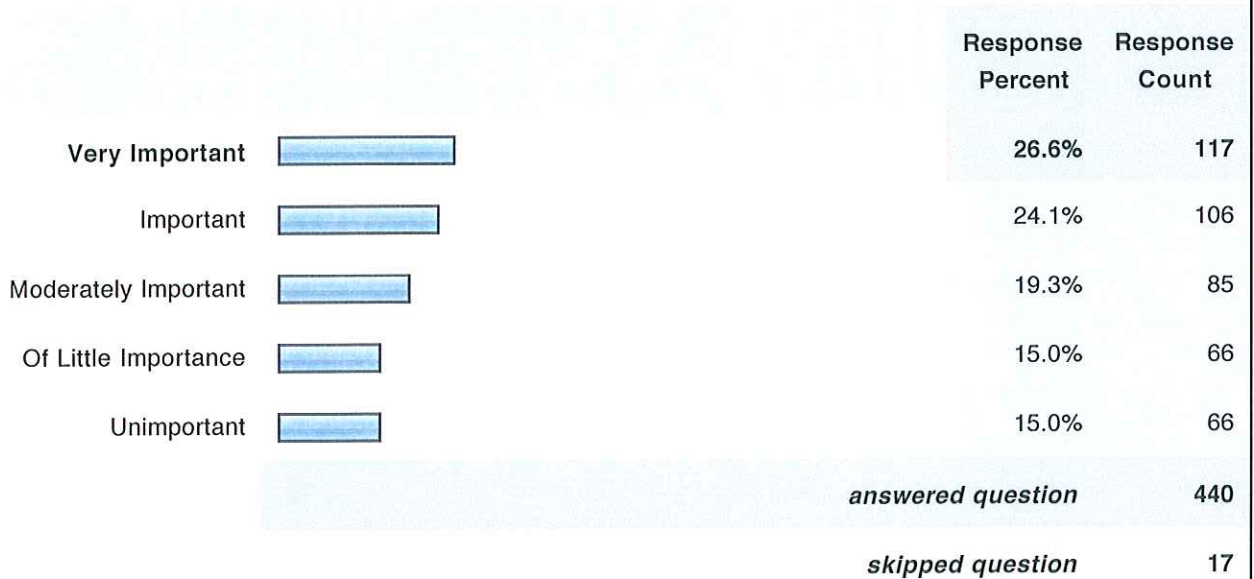
8. Do you support the presence of pre-school programs in Penn Manor's elementary buildings?



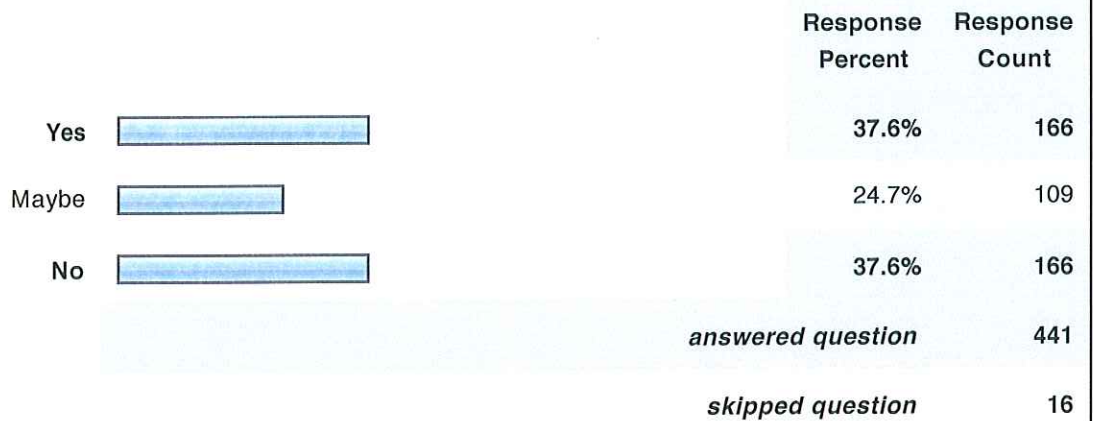
9. How important are school sports and co-curricular programs (intramurals, clubs, dramatics, music, contests, etc.) for children in our community?



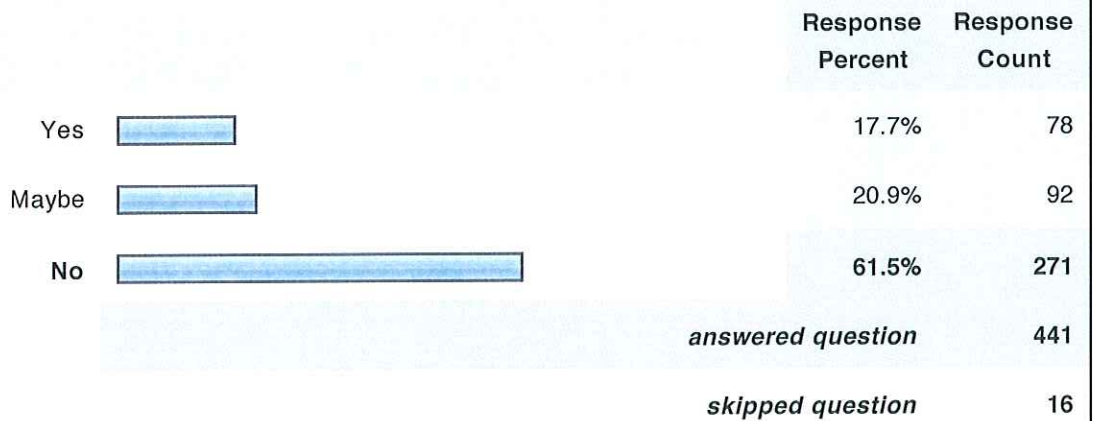
10. How important to you is the concept of a community recreation center within the Penn Manor School District?



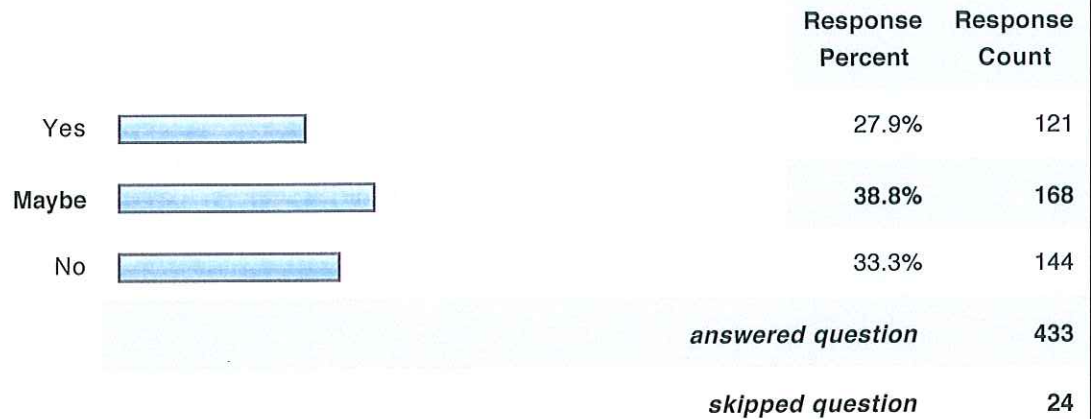
11. Should Penn Manor explore the use of public funds to support the development of a community recreation center?



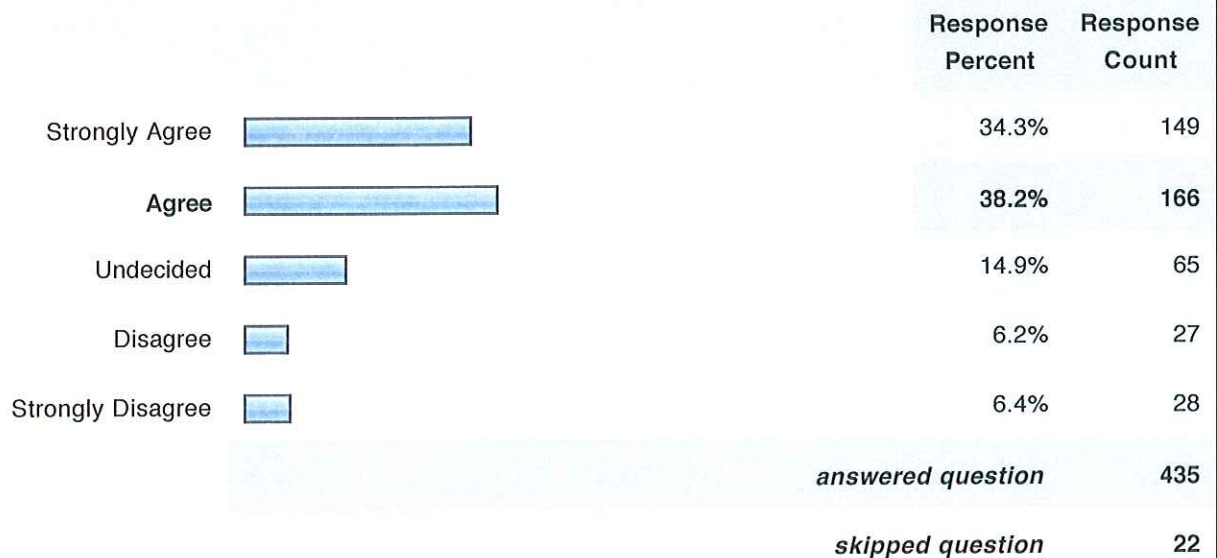
12. Do you support the use of public school funds to construct a Penn Manor School District football stadium in lieu of the district's lease of the Millersville University Stadium?
