MINUTES Penn Manor Board of School Directors September 7, 2022

A special meeting of the Board of Directors of the Penn Manor School District was held on the above date in the Large Group Instruction Room at Penn Manor High School. The meeting was called to order by Board President, Carlton L. Rintz, at 5:00 p.m.

The applicants were ranked by each board member until there were two left for consideration – Anthony Lombardo and Matthew Beakes. The following straw vote was taken on this motion. Dr. Fullerton, Lombardo; Mr. Herr, Lombardo; Mr. Jackson, Lombardo; Mrs. Nafziger, Beakes; Mr. Rintz, Lombardo; Mr. Straub, Lombardo; Mr. Sweigart, Lombardo; Ms. Wert, Beakes.

Anthony Lombardo will be recommended to fill the open board seat at the Monday, September 19, 2022 board meeting.

Mr. Rintz asked if there were any citizens who wished to make a comment to the board. District residents, Colleen Milligan and Carmen Epstein, commented on the deliberation method.
